

# Acceptable Forms of Photo Identification

---



## State

- A valid state driver's license, state identification card, permanent resident card, military identification card, passport, immigration card, or a valid tribal identification card which shows that the person is 21 years of age or older.

## Federal

- Unless otherwise required by state or local law, FDA recommends that retailers accept only government-issued photographic identification with the bearer's date of birth. (e.g., State-issued driver's license or identification card, military identification card, passport or immigration card) for establishing a legal age to purchase FDA regulated products.

**NOTE: AN EXPIRED CARD IS NOT ACCEPTABLE!**
